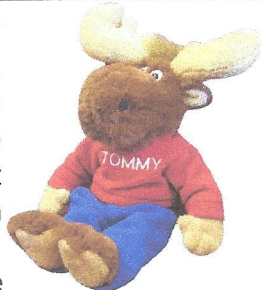

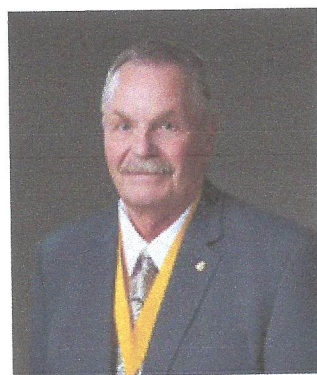


to work on this and other update projects to continue growing and sustaining this lodge for generations to come.
